- Analysis of works by AAAPI composers
- Research related to AAAPI cultural heritage and music
- Topics of Transnationalism as it relates to musicians and composers
- Pedagogy, Curriculum, and disciplinary concerns

Please submit <u>this Google form</u> with the following information :

- Proposals should not exceed 300 words and must be anonymised.
- Accepted papers will be allotted 25 minutes for presentation plus 15 minutes for questions.
- Applicants may choose to also include supporting materials (e.g. musical example, figures, tables, selected bibliography, etc.), which will be uploaded separately on the google form.
